IGP Aude - Red - 2023

LOCATION

Located in the heart of Southern France, the IGP Aude wine region benefits from a Mediterranean climate with diverse soils ranging from limestone to clay and gravel. This protected geographical indication allows for a wide variety of grape varieties and wine styles, offering approachable, fruit-driven wines that showcase the richness and character of the Aude terroir.

PRESENTATION

Belle France focuses on culture, Haussmannian architecture and the French art of living. Discover its Bordeaux wine, a testimony to this refinement.

WINEMAKING & AGEING

Red wines under the IGP Aude designation are typically produced through traditional vinification methods. After harvest, grapes are destemmed and undergo temperature-controlled fermentation to preserve fruit aromas. Depending on the style, maceration lasts 1-3 weeks to extract color and tannins. The wines are then gently pressed, aged in stainless steel tanks or oak barrels, and bottled to retain freshness and balance.




VARIETALS Merlot 100%



TASTING

Bright ruby color with expressive aromas of ripe red berries, subtle spices, and a hint of Mediterranean herbs. On the palate, it is smooth and fruit-forward, with soft tannins and a balanced finish, making it an easy-drinking and versatile red wine.
